

FRANCE, 26 avril, 1976.

Messieurs,

Une nouvelle junta militaire implantée en Amérique Latine est mise en place cette fois en Argentine, aussi répressive et sanglante que la junta militaire chilienne. C'est la raison pour laquelle elle doit recourir afin de maintenir sa position à la pratique d'une répression toujours plus violente, cherchant d'un côté à éliminer toute possibilité d'organisation des secteurs susceptibles de s'opposer à elle et essayant, d'un autre côté, de désarticuler ceux qui sont déjà organisés et ont commencé à déployer une opposition chaque jour plus forte.

C'est dans un tel contexte, que la junta nie qu'elle maintient prisonniers, un grand nombre de personnes portées disparues à la suite d'une arrestation non dissimulée par ses organismes répressifs. Dans certains cas, cette situation se prolonge, dans d'autres, les protestations internationales ont obligé la junta à confirmer la détention, ou bien elle s'est vue contrainte de reconnaître elle-même les faits afin de juger les prisonniers, de les condamner, ou d'entamer toute autre procédure qui fait que leur situation se clarifie.

C'est pour toutes ces raisons que nous vous demandons d'exiger la clarification de la situation et la libération immédiate de EDUARDO HERRIGONZA, membre de la Commission Politique du Mouvement de la Gauche Révolutionnaire du Chili, emprisonné par les appareils policiers de la junta Argentine, le 10 avril, lequel risque d'être envoyé au Chili, comme il y a eu d'autres cas par exemple celui de Jorge Fuentes arrêté à la frontière Argentine-Paraguay et de Guillermo Resusaire Alonso, arrêté le 2-11-74 à l'Aéroport de Ezeiza à Buenos Aires Argentine.

Veuillez agréer, Messieurs, l'expression de notre considération distinguée.

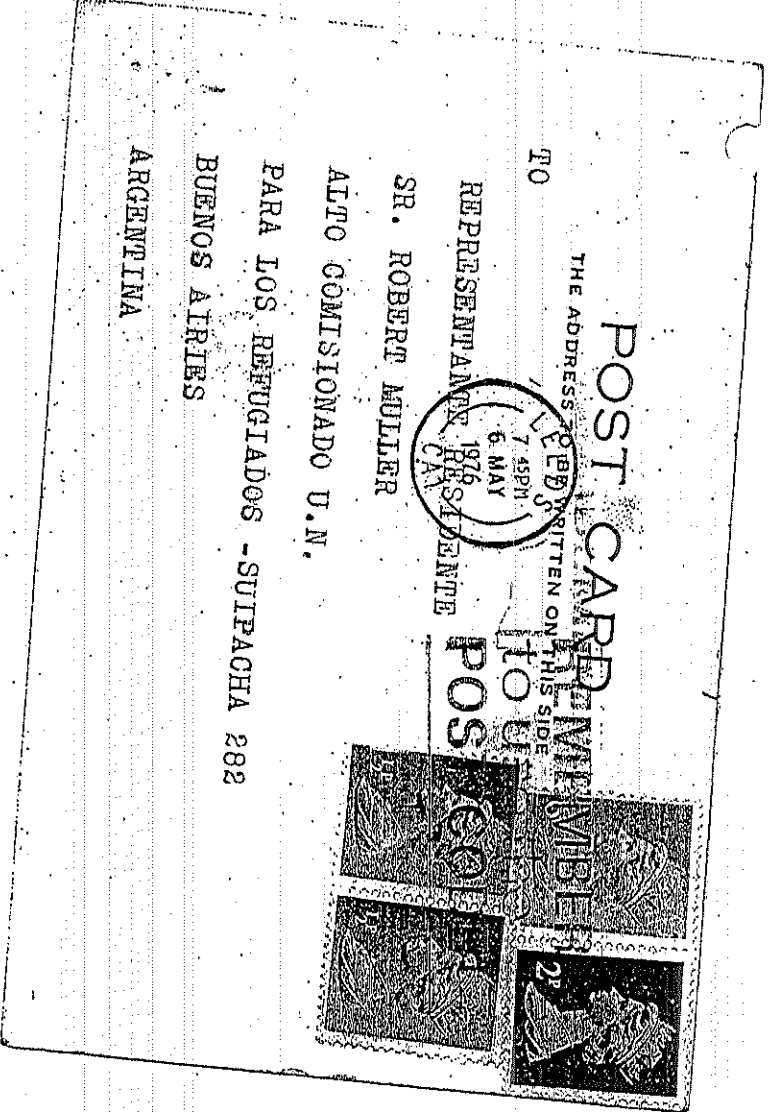

Dear Mr. Muller,

I have been informed that Edgardo Enriquez, a Chilean citizen, has disappeared in the Argentine and is believed to have been arrested and imprisoned. I understand that there is a possibility that he might be deported to Chile, which in view of his opposition to the present Chilean regime, would be an extremely serious move. I trust that information as to the whereabouts of Edgardo Enriquez will soon be made available, and I wish to press that he should receive fair treatment according to law, and should not be handed over to the Chilean authorities. I hope it will be possible for you to intervene in this matter with the Argentinian authorities.

Dear Mr. Muller,

It has come to my attention that a Chilean citizen called EDGARDO ENRIQUEZ is at present being detained in Buenos Aires after having been arrested on Saturday 10th April 1976.

He is a member of the Chilean Resistance (M.I.R.) and it is my fear that your government will have him transferred back to Chile in which case he will almost certainly be submitted to brutal torture in a concentration camp.

I have every faith in your government that you will do your best to respect the conventions of national law and international law to ensure humane treatment while he remains in detention in Argentina.

As a Christian I beg you in all humanity to save the life of this person and not to hand him over to the Chilean Junta which can only mean a brutal death.

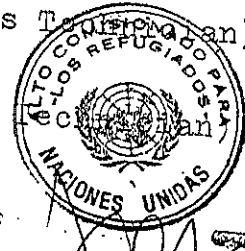

I have just learned from a colleague here at the University that a Chilean Socialist called Edgardo Estay was arrested in Buenos Aires on 10 April and that there is a danger that he may be sent back to Chile. I have written together with a number of colleagues, to ask the Minister of Home Affairs, Sr. Alvaro Argandoña, to show leniency to Sr. Estay, considering the probable nature of the fate that awaits him in Chile, and I would also like to urge you to intervene on his behalf and prevent his repatriation.
